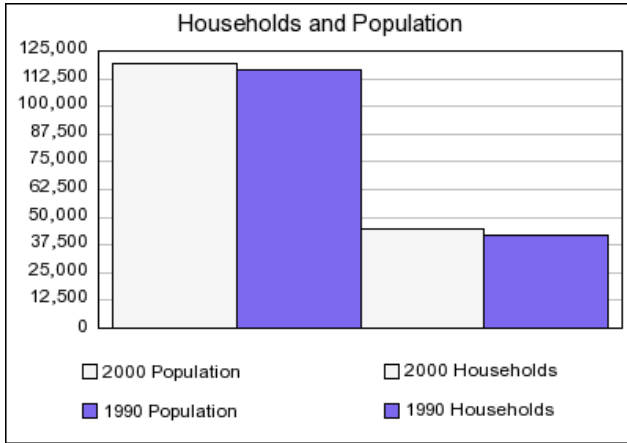

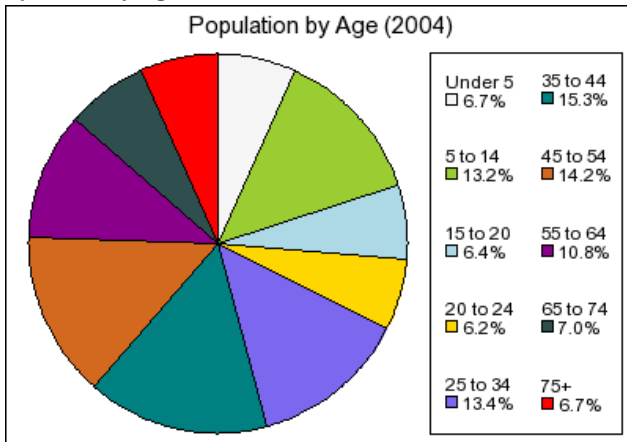
Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **42,206** and changed to **44,539** in 2000, representing a change of **6%**. The household count in 2004 was **44,140** and the household projection for 2009 is **43,861**, a change of **-1%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **116,123** and in 2000 it was **119,320**, roughly a **3%** change. The population in 2004 was **118,648** and the projection for 2009 is **118,264** representing a change of **-0%**.

Population by Age



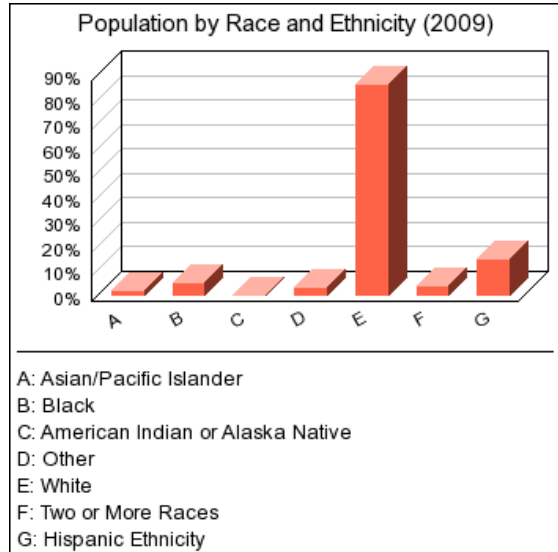
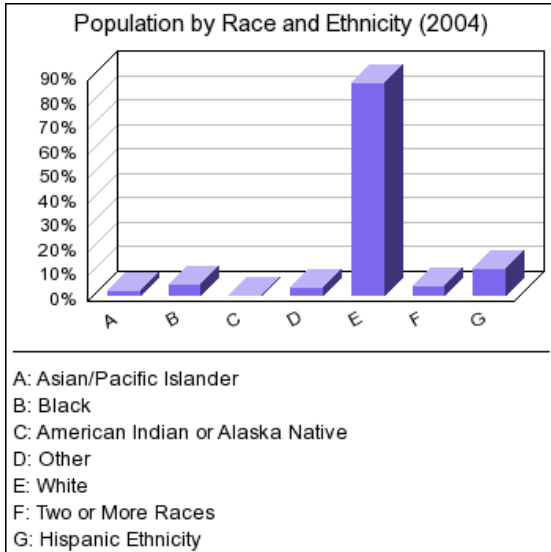
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **33.4**, and in 2000, it was **36.6**. The median age in 2004 is **37.7** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39.0** years.

In 2004, females represented **51.3%** of the population with a median age of **39.3** and males represented **48.7%** of the population with a median age of **36.2** years.

In 2004, the most prominent age group in this geography is **35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

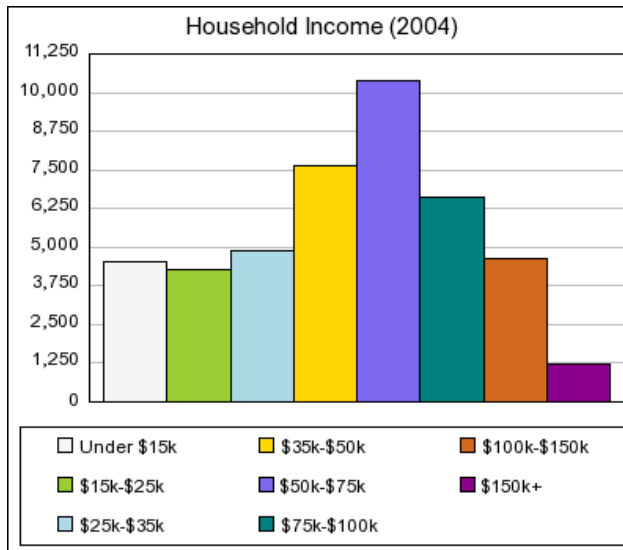
Population by Race/Ethnicity
